Posology and Method of Administration - 50g Cream

This product is not recommended for use in children under 12 years of age.

Adults, elderly and children aged 12 years and above:
Apply a thick layer to the affected area 2 times daily and gently massage into the skin. Can be applied up to 4 times daily if needed. If the condition worsens or if symptoms do not improve within 7 days, consult a doctor or qualified healthcare practitioner

Contraindications :

Hypersensitivity to Rhus toxicodendron (poison ivy) and Arnica Montana (arnica) or other plants of the daisy family (Asteraceae/Compositae) or plants of the cashew family or any other ingredients in this product.

Posology and Method of Administration - 50 Tablets

Adults, elderly and children aged 12 years and above:

Take 1 tablet 3 times daily.

If needed, one tablet can be taken every 1/2 hour to 1 hour up to 12 times in the first 24 hours. Then continue with one tablet three times daily.

The tablets should be allowed to dissolve in the mouth at least 30 minutes before meals.

If the condition worsens or if symptoms do not improve within 7 days, consult a doctor or qualified healthcare practitioner

Contraindications :

Hypersensitivity to Rhus toxicodendron (poison ivy) and Arnica Montana (arnica) or other plants of the daisy family (Asteraceae/Compositae), or plants of the cashew family or any other ingredients in this product.

Zeel Comp vs Diclofenac - Summary

The efficacy of Zeel comp was compared to that of Diclofenac in the context of a randomised, controlled, double-blind study. Both preparations were administered three times daily over a period of 10 weeks (concentration of Diclofenac tablet = 25mg) to 125 patients in total. The characterisation (anamnesis) of the osteoarthritis was carried out at the beginning of the study by the physician.

The results were:

- The study demonstrated that the efficacy of Zeel Comp (tablets) in treating mild to moderate gonarthrosis is equivalent to the efficacy of Diclofenac.
- Furthermore, the study proved a parallel confirmation of the safety of Zeel comp (tablets).
